Vacation Bible School is just around the corner. We are really excited about this years VBS. We are doing Lifeway's Twist's & Turns. I get to teach the oldest kids, the 6th grade and up class.

When you think about that age group...that's really the age when kids start thinking about what they want to do with their life. What classes they're going to take in highschool. What career they'd like to pursue. These are some big decisions!

The scripture for the first night of VBS is from Psalm 25:4, which says,

4 Show me the right path, O LORD; point out the road for me to follow. Psalms 25:4 (NLT)

Sometimes, we need to pray for direction. Sometimes, God will give us a clear sense of direction. In that case, it's a matter of following God's chosen path.

Do you all remember the arcade game PACMAN? I'm sure we've all played PACMAN at the arcade at one time or another.

There are a couple of ways to beat the pacman game. One way to beat it is to memorize the correct path for each level. An example of a correct path is shown below:



I had a record with arcade music on it...and the sleeve of the record showed the correct path for each level of pacman so that you could beat the whole game on one quarter if you successfully followed it.

But...what if you didn't have the map with you, and you haven't memorized the correct path? Well, there is another thing that will help you with packman. Each of the four ghosts have a different personality.

- Blinky (the red ghost) This ghost is very aggressive and will chase you across the maze.
- Pinky (the pink ghost) Pinky normally tries to get in front of you to cut you off.
- Inky (the light blue ghost) This is the hardest ghost...he just follows a random pattern.
- Clyde (the orange ghost) He seems frightened, he normally tries to go the other way from you.

If you know these patterns, the way the ghosts behave...then you can regonize the danger and stay away.

Our lives are kindof like this. If God has made clear to you His will for your life...then stay on the narrow road...stay on the path you know you should follow.

At other times...we have choices...and we've prayed...and God's will is still not clear. In those instances...thank God for the freedom to chose...and chose ways that do not lead into sin and danger. Reconzie how sin works. See it for what it is...and by avoiding sin, you can get where God wants you to be.
